Term 1 - 2022

Science

Living things and their habitats

We will explore a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there, learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive and make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there including microhabitats.

Maths

Numbers within 100: Read, write, represent, partition, compare and order numbers to 100.
Addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers: Apply number bonds to add and subtract and represent and explain addition and subtraction of two 2-digit numbers.
Addition and subtraction word problems: Introduction to bar models as a representation and create, label and sketch bar models.

Fiction: We will be using interesting adjectives to write a character description of Mr Twit and have fun inventing our own evil characters.
