

French:

The unit we will begin with is called My Home and we will learn all about the different rooms and types of houses we live in.

Mathematics:

We will be using the Mastery approach in Mathematics to develop much deeper conceptual understanding of numbers. Units will include: Place value and number, addition and subtraction, statistics, multiplication and division

Maths Meetings:

We will be doing daily maths meetings to embed sound knowledge and understanding of the topics we have previously covered. We will also use these meetings to become proficient time tellers.

English:

We are following Talk for Reading and Talk for Writing, linked to high quality texts and poems. This term we will be studying the book Cosmic, which ties in nicely with our Science topic. Writing genres will include story writing, poetry, recounts and historical writing.

GPS – Spellings will be taught weekly and these will include words based on particular spelling patterns and words from the National Curriculum statutory spelling lists for years 5 and 6. Improving handwriting will be a key focus for us this year, as well as improving grammar and punctuation in writing in all subjects.

Geography:

In the second half of the Autumn term we will begin studying Geography. We will develop our map reading skills and study the world around us, both here and overseas. We will learn about both human and physical geography.

History:**The effects of the Anglo-Saxon, Viking and Scots Settlement in Britain**

This term we are exploring Britain's settlement of Anglo-Saxons and Scots and the Vikings, and the Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England up to the time of Edward the Confessor.

Science:

This term our topic in Science is Earth & Space. We will study Earth and our neighbouring planets including their relative sizes and distances in relation to the Sun. We will look at the geological history of Earth, from early planetary formation through to the present and also examine what the potential future holds for our planet.
